The Macquarie Institute for Innovation is pleased to offer two (2) Scholarships to attend the REE Asia 2007 conference at KAIST, Seoul, South Korea - June 20 - 22, 2007. These scholarships are intended for an early career educators in the field of entrepreneurship.

SCHOLARSHIP VALUE

The value of the scholarship is one return economy class airfare to Seoul, approximately A\$2,500.00

Note: The recipients of the scholarship will be responsible for accommodation and registration fees.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Australian or New Zealand citizen, or resident with appropriate work visa
- Minimum age requirement of 18 years old as of June 2007.
- Early career academic who has been employed at an Australian/New Zealand educational institution for less than five years.
- Must have a PhD or be enrolled for a PhD in the area of entrepreneurship and you have made a positive contribution to the field.
- All applicants must be prepared to attend the REE ASIA 2007 conference in Korea on June 20 – 22, 2007.

IMPORTANT DATES

- Applications close on Friday, May 4, 2007
- Applications received after the closing date will not be considered for this scholarship.
- Finalists for interviews will be advised by email by Friday, May 11, 2007.
- Where possible, interviews will be conducted during the week of May 14, 2007 and winners advised immediately thereafter.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Academics, who meet scholarship eligibility criteria can apply for the scholarship.

Payment of the scholarship amount will be reimbursed to the scholarship holder upon receipt of invoice for the scholarship value.

HOW TO APPLY

Step 1: Complete the Scholarship form

Your completed application must contain:

- Scholarship application form.
 - This form includes:
 - Personal contact details; and
 - A summary paper which covers applicant's commitment to entrepreneurship education. Specifically to include the following:
 - Statement on the benefits you will gain from attending the REE Asia 2007 Conference
 - Statement on how you would utilize the experience you would gain by attending the Conference
 - Statement on how attending this conference would improve your teaching and learning skills.
- Brief CV not more than one page. This should include:
 - PhD in the field or evidence of progress towards one;
 - Any relevant industry experience
 - Teaching experience and record; and/or
 - Service to applicant's institution in the field of entrepreneurship education.
- Two references regarding applicant's achievements in the field of entrepreneurship (recommendation: head of school department)

Step 3: Selection Process

Assessment Criteria

- Up to six (6) finalists will be invited to an interview either in person or via conference call.
- Entries will be judged by the Committee on the basis of:
 - Candidate's record of achievement in entrepreneurship education and scholarship
 - Evidence of candidate's commitment to the development of entrepreneurship education
 - Evidence that the candidate will benefit from attending REE Asia 2007, and is willing to contribute towards REE Asia 2008
- The Committee reserves the right not to declare any winner if there is no suitable application. The decision of the Committee is final and the applicant must accept that he/she cannot appeal against the Committee's decision to any person or body.
- Winners once notified must make their arrangements to attend the REE Asia 2007 conference and notify Sharen Page of these arrangements within one week of notification, otherwise, the scholarship will be forfeited.
